REIMBURSEMENT FEE SCHEDULE

Reimbursement Stand-by Fire Protection Services due to Product Release or Other Similar Emergencies. Personnel and Apparatus reimbursements also apply to stand-by services required by Fire Code.

In the event of a spill the spiller **may** receive abatement services from the City of Newton Fire Department for the first initial hour at no cost, but shall be subject to reimbursement fees for every hour there after.

Ladder	\$91.00 per hour
Tanker Operation	\$91.00 per hour
All other Apparatus	\$91.00 per hour
Personnel	\$25.00 per hour
Incident Supplies	At the current Replacement Costs
Decontamination / Replacement of Equipment	At the current Replacement Costs

The City of Newton Fire Department shall recognize the following products referenced in the DOT Emergency Response Guidebook as hazardous products:

- Class 1 - Explosives
 - Division 1.1 Explosives with a mass explosion hazard
 - Division 1.2 Explosives with a projection hazard
 - Division 1.3 Explosives with predominantly a fire hazard
 - Division 1.4 Explosives with no significant blast hazard
 - Division 1.5 Very insensitive explosives; blasting agents
 - Division 1.6 Extremely insensitive detonating articles
- Class 2- Gases
 - Division 2.1 Flammable gases
 - Division 2.2 Non-flammable, non-toxic* compressed gases

- Division 2.3 Gases toxic* by inhalation
 - Division 2.4 Corrosive gases (Canada)
- Class 3- Flammable liquids (and Combustible liquids [US])
- Class 4- Flammable solids; Spontaneously combustible materials; and Dangerous when wet materials
 - Division 4.1 Flammable solids
 - Division 4.2 Spontaneously combustible materials
 - Division 4.3 Dangerous when wet materials
- Class 5- Oxidizers and Organic peroxides
 - Division 5.1 Oxidizer
 - Division 5.2 Organic peroxides
- Class 6- Toxic* materials and Infectious substances
 - Division 6.1 Toxic* materials
 - Division 6.2 Infectious substances
- Class 7- Radioactive materials
- Class 8- Corrosive materials
- Class 9- Miscellaneous dangerous goods
 - Division 9.1 Miscellaneous dangerous goods (Canada)
 - Division 9.2 Environmentally hazardous substances (Canada)
 - Division 9.3 Dangerous wastes (Canada)
