Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment **#2011-05** originated by the **Newton City Council** proposes to amend the Zoning Ordinance as it pertains to temporary signs throughout the City and its Extraterritorial Planning Jurisdiction. The ordinance would exempt temporary signs from permit requirements, allow an unlimited number of temporary signs, balloons, aerial signs or banners to be erected at any location within the City or its planning jurisdiction for a period not to exceed seven days for the purpose of announcing commercial and non-commercial openings, closings, management changes, special events and sales provided such signs do not create a hazard to public safety.
